This policy serves to protect our patients, our company, and our community from misuse or misunderstanding, so both website and social media efforts can achieve our intentions of positive, two-way communication.

By accessing, viewing, participating, or posting on any MCO website or social media platform, you agree to the terms of this policy. Your use of MCO social media sites is acceptance of this policy and has the same effect as if you had physically signed an agreement. Please be aware that MCO:

- reserves the right to monitor, prohibit, restrict, block, suspend, terminate, delete, or discontinue your access to any MCO social media site, at any time, without notice and for any reason and at their sole discretion.
 - may remove, delete, block, filter, or restrict by any other means any materials posted, placed, or found within an MCO social media platform, and do so at their sole discretion.
 - may communicate and remarket to those who have visited our website and social channels to improve communication and increase accessibility to MCO services.
 - may utilize posted information for promotional, educational, or general communication purposes; information may be shared, commented upon, or used in any way.

- will not transmit any material (by uploading, posting, email, or otherwise) that is unlawful, disruptive, threatening, profane, abusive, harassing, embarrassing, tortuous, defamatory, obscene, libelous, or is an invasion of another's privacy, is hateful or racially, ethnically or otherwise objectionable as solely determined in MCO's discretion.
 - will not impersonate any person or entity or falsely state or otherwise misrepresent your affiliation with a person or entity.
 - will not transmit any material (by uploading, posting, email, or otherwise) that you do not have a right to make available under any law or contractual or fiduciary relationships.
 - will not transmit any material (by uploading, posting, email, or otherwise) that infringes any patent, trademark, trade secret, copyright, or other proprietary rights of any party.

You agree that any claim or dispute relating to your posting of any content on a social media site on the internet shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois and you agree to be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the local, state, or federal courts located in McLean County, Illinois.
